Two 3-metre-wide paths, one running from Station Road straight across the green, the other branching off this path curving towards the left. The rest of the area will be left for wildflowers. BD will prepare an illustrated map. The map and the leaflet will be distributed to nearby houses.

5.5. Tommy.

AH has repaired the Tommy in the Memorial Garden, in time for the D-Day celebrations on 6 June 2024. The Tommy had been broken off and was laying in the hedge. AH added some steel to reinforce it and re-painted it black where required.
